The most common reason is that kids are no longer having fun. Winning games is often emphasized more than developing as players and enjoying competing with friends. The experience is not positive for many.

The first characteristic of the Total Player is "Play with Passion". One of our main goals is to encourage players to play with all their heart but we also want them to feel loved. Our training sessions are designed to be challenging, fun and encouraging. Each session includes a Total Player devotional. Our motivation comes from the fact that God is passionate for each individual. We can have fun playing soccer but everlasting joy comes through our relationship with Him.

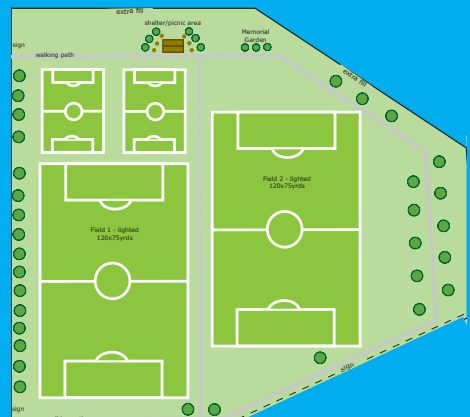
At mid-day, all gets quiet as teams settle down for their

Brazil Project directors, Vanio and Wanina Robeiro, have been a huge blessing and encouragement in our lives and ministry. In March 2010, they believed God was leading them back to Campo Grande where both of them grew up. So they packed up and moved.

Wanina writes: "PLEASE PRAY FOR OUR TOWN!!! It's a very poor town. There are a lot of prostitution, drugs, drinkers, robberies, violence, etc... Guys, our dream is about to come true! The ON GOAL Brazil project is already a bomb in hell. Many, many souls will know the Lord Jesus through ON GOAL in Campo Grande. We are so happy seeing how God works. He is so faithful!"

Since the Robeiros began the new project, the local government has given them land to build a facility. Their vision is for it to include a soccer field, futsal court, classrooms, an office and missionary dorms. They are aiming to raise funds locally but are in need of others to share the vision.

Wanina also writes: "We started going into a place called 'Lixao' (garbage). It's a place where all the garbage from the city goes to. There are a lot of children, who survive through the garbage foods and stuff. It's horrible! We are attending about 100 kids there every Sunday morning. They have a dirt soccer field. Praise the Lord! Last Sunday On Goal had about 25 volunteers from our church helping out."
